



IMMUNIZATION AND LICENSED CHILD CARE

BC Child Care Licensing Regulation (Section 19) requires that all employees and volunteers in licensed child care facilities provide evidence of their immunization status. As a person who comes into regular contact with young children, it is important for you, your family, and those you care for that you ensure you have up-to-date immunizations.

Please see the attached immunization schedules, as per the guidelines from Vancouver Coastal Health, and consult with your medical professional with regards to the vaccines that are right for you.

Some of the recommended vaccines for child care employees and volunteers are:

- Tetanus/Diphtheria
 - MMR (Measles/Mumps/Rubella)
 - Flu (Influenza)
 - Chickenpox (if you have not had it before)
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CONFIRMATION OF IMMUNIZATION STATUS FOR EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS

As an employee or volunteer of Parkgate Community Services Society, I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that I have received the recommended immunizations:

Please check one of the following:

- I have been immunized and I have attached a photocopy of my record indicating the immunizations and dates received
- I have been immunized and I DO NOT have a record of my immunizations
- I am choosing NOT to get further immunization at this time

*I understand that should there be an outbreak of a communicable disease for which immunization is available, I may be asked to produce a record of immunizations, and **may be excluded immediately** from working or volunteering, as per direction from the Vancouver Coastal Health Medical Health Officer.*

This exclusion will last until:

- *The end of the outbreak, or as recommended by the Medical Health Officer*
- OR**
- *I can provide proof that I have the required immunization*
